Mayor Yaede Calls For Follow-up Meeting Open to Public



In February, at a meeting with Trenton Mayor Eric Jackson, a follow-up meeting was agreed to be scheduled within 45 days; however was not yet scheduled. In late April, Mayor Yaede wrote to Mayor Jackson and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Acting Commissioner Catherine McCabe for both the convening of the promised meeting, along with Mayor Yaede's desire for the meeting to be open to the public.

In particular, Mayor Yaede wants to make sure that the City of Trenton is meeting deadlines imposed by the Department of Environmental Protection through the Administrative Consent Order that was finalized earlier this year.

Just this week, a follow-up meeting was scheduled; however City of Trenton officials did not open this meeting to the public.

Recently, some residents with Trenton Water may have received a letter regarding a program in which the City of Trenton, through contractors, would replace lateral service pipes (which are the responsibility of a resident) for a cost.

In response, Mayor Yaede again wrote to Trenton Mayor Eric Jackson to request that Trenton Water Works:

- 1) Hold **Public Information Sessions** to help answer questions for residents (Mayor Yaede also offered to find a meeting location in Hamilton for the convenience of residents)
- 2) The the City of Trenton **extend the deadline** by which residents would need to make a decision on whether or not to participate by
