**Project:** Contract TS-447B, Calhoun Street Toll-Supported Bridge Rehabilitation Project

**Route/Direction/MP:** Calhoun St. Bridge spanning the Delaware River between NJ Rt. 29 and PA Rt. 32

**Municipality/County:** Trenton / Mercer County  
Morrisville / Bucks County

**Nature of work:** Bridge Reconstruction

**Anticipated Traffic Impacts:** The Calhoun Street Bridge is scheduled to be permanently closed for reconstruction work for four months between Monday May 24<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 AM until Friday September 24<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 PM. All traffic will follow the approved detour to the Lower Trenton Bridge just south of the Calhoun St. Bridge during this reconstruction project. The detour signage will be installed and covered prior to the closure date.

### **Description of New Traffic Pattern:**

New Jersey traffic will be detoured to NJ Route 29 SB to Market Street to S. Warren Street and crossing the Delaware River on the "Trenton Makes" Bridge into Pennsylvania to E. Bridge Street to PA Route 32 NB (Delmorr Avenue) to Trenton Avenue (Calhoun Street). Pennsylvania traffic will follow the same detour in reverse.

### **Proposed Start Date of New Traffic Pattern:**

Monday, May 24, 2010

**Any other comments:** The Commission will provide a VMS board on the right shoulder of southbound Rt. 29 near the entrance of the Trenton Water Treatment Plant displaying advanced notification of the bridge closure date. The NJDOT offered to activate their existing VMS(s) notifying northbound Rt. 29 traffic of the bridge closure date. These VMS's were activated 5/10/2010.
