ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, PART II, GENERAL LEGISLATION, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE III, TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, § 485-27, TURN PROHIBITIONS, WHICH ESTABLISHED CERTAIN TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON ON QUAKERBRIDGE ROAD, HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY INCLUDING THE APPLICATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF SUBTITLE ONE OF TITLE 39 OF THE NEW JERSEY STATUTES

**Chapter 485
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC
Article III - Traffic Regulations**

§ 485-27. Turn prohibitions.

No person shall turn at the below described locations as indicated.

Location	Direction of Travel	Turn Prohibited	At Intersection of
Paxson Avenue	Both	U-turn	Between the northernmost intersection of Tarheels Road to the southernmost intersection of Tarheels Road
<u>Quakerbridge Road (CR #533)</u>	<u>Eastbound Driveway</u>	<u>Tractor Trailers Left Turn (6:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.)</u>	<u>3600 and 3620 Quakerbridge Road Driveway</u>
Quakerbridge Road (CR #533)	North	Left	Clearview Avenue
<u>Quakerbridge Road (CR #533)</u>	<u>Northbound</u>	<u>Tractor Trailers Left Turn (6:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.)</u>	<u>3600 and 3620 Quakerbridge Road Driveway</u>
Quakerbridge Road (CR #533)	South	Right	Clearview Avenue

Signs. All signs shall conform to the current edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-198 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-183.27. The Applicant/Owner shall erect all such traffic control devices in accordance with this Ordinance.

Severability. Should any portion of this Ordinance be declared invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions shall remain valid and of full force and effect.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect no less than 20 days after its final passage by the Council of the Township of Hamilton and its approval by the Mayor of the Township of Hamilton, approval by the Commissioner of Transportation, and publication thereof according to law.
