ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING; § 485-19, HANDICAPPED PARKING (Establishing space for 512 Johnston Avenue; and 115 Mary Street)

Whereas the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to establish handicapped parking spaces on streets for private residences;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey, Chapter 485, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II; Parking, § 485-19, Handicapped Parking, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 485

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Article II – Parking

§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

Street	Location
<u>512 Johnston Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08629</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 170 feet north of Tipton Street and extending to a point 192 feet north of Tipton Street along the east curb line of Johnston Avenue.</u>
<u>115 Mary Street</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 78 feet west of S. Clinton Avenue and extending to a point 100 feet west of S. Clinton Avenue along the north curb line of Mary Street.</u>
