TITLE

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING; § 485-19, HANDICAPPED PARKING (Establishing space for 1228 Deutz Avenue; 306 S. Johnston Avenue; and 25 Tuttle Avenue)

Whereas the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to establish handicapped parking spaces on streets for private residences;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey, Chapter 485, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II; Parking, § 485-19, Handicapped Parking, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 485

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Article II – Parking

§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

Street	Location
<u>1228 Deutz Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08611</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 62 feet north of High Street and extending to a point 84 feet north of High Street along the east curb line of Deutz Avenue.</u>
<u>306 S. Johnston Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08609</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 40 feet south of Brookside Avenue and extending to a point 62 feet south of Brookside Avenue along the east curb line of S. Johnston Avenue.</u>

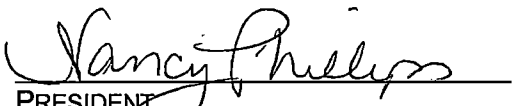

<u>25 Tuttle Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08629</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 90 feet south of Austin Avenue and extending to a point 112 feet south of Austin Avenue along the east curb line of Tuttle Avenue.</u>

Any Ordinance or Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
