ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING; § 485-19, HANDICAPPED PARKING (Establishing space for 25 Annabelle Avenue; 18 Bismark Avenue; 1620 East State Street; and 87 Newkirk Avenue)

Whereas the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to establish handicapped parking spaces on streets for private residences;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey, Chapter 485, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II; Parking, § 485-19, Handicapped Parking, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 485

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Article II – Parking

§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.

.....

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

Street	Location
<u>25 Annabelle Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 234 feet west of South Broad Street and extending to a point 256 feet west of South Broad Street along the north curb line of Annabelle Avenue.</u>
<u>18 Bismark Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 164 feet south of Dewey Avenue and extending to a point 186 feet south of Dewey Avenue along the east curb line of Bismark Avenue.</u>

<u>1620 East State Street</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08609</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 141 feet east of North Johnston Avenue and extending to a point 163 feet east of North Johnston Avenue along the north curb line of East State Street.</u>
<u>87 Newkirk Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08629</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 111 feet north of Liberty Street and extending to a point 133 feet north of Liberty Street along the west curb line of Newkirk Avenue.</u>

Any Ordinance or Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

A copy of this Ordinance shall be forwarded to the County of Mercer, as East State Street (CR 535) is under County jurisdiction, and a consenting resolution from the Mercer County Board of County Commissioners will be required.
