**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON TO ACCEPT A GIFT FROM SEAN'S LANDSCAPING, INC. FOR THE DONATION OF MATERIALS AND LABOR TO ENHANCE THE 9-11 MEMORIAL LOCATED WITHIN VETERANS PARK**

*Whereas* September 11, 2021 will mark the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center in New York, the Pentagon in Washington D.C. and Shanksville, Pennsylvania; and

*Whereas* the Township of Hamilton desires to enhance its 9-11 Memorial located within Veterans Park to commemorate this solemn occasion, and to pay further tribute to all of those brave individuals that lost their lives on that day; and

*Whereas* in October of 2020, the Township obtained a proposal from a private landscaping company for the desired improvements to the 9-11 Memorial, and said quote for the project totaled \$72,015.00; and

*Whereas* Sean's Landscaping, Inc. has generously offered to provide and install granite pavers for the Township of Hamilton's 9-11 Memorial, with said donation to include setting bed, granite pavers and additional pavers as needed to enhance the memorial, at no cost to the Township; and

*Whereas* soils, plantings, mulch and sod will be provided and installed as needed; and

*Whereas* the Township of Hamilton wishes to accept the generous gifts from Sean's Landscaping, Inc. and memorialize their donation of materials and labor to enhance the 9-11 Memorial located within Veterans Park; and

*Whereas* N.J.S.A. 40A:12-29 states in relevant part that any municipality may accept donations, by gift, bequest, or devise, of real property, funds, personal property, in-kind items, or services by private persons to the soliciting governmental entity, for the purpose of the maintenance of public parks, and that any solicitation for a donation of \$7,500 or more in value shall be made a matter of public record by the municipality by adoption of an ordinance authorizing the solicitation; and

*Whereas* the authorization of the aforementioned acceptance of this donation is in the best interest of the citizens of the Township;

*Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained* by the Council of the Township of Hamilton in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the proper officials of the Township of Hamilton be and hereby are authorized to accept the donation from Sean's Landscaping, Inc. and
