ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 385, SEWERS AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL, ARTICLE III, CONNECTION TO SANITARY SEWER REQUIRED; EXCEPTIONS, § 385-13, CONNECTION FEE; PERMIT

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the *Code of the Township of Hamilton, New Jersey, Chapter 385, Sewers and Sewage Disposal, Article III, Connection to Sanitary Sewer Required; Exceptions, § 385-13, Connection fee; permit*, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 385

SEWERS AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL

ARTICLE III - CONNECTION TO SANITARY SEWER REQUIRED; EXCEPTIONS

.....

§ 385-13. Connection fee; permit.

- A. Each applicant for a permit for each connection from a single-family residential dwelling to the sewer system shall pay a fee as set forth in Chapter 215, Fees, of the Township Code for a permit to make the connection. The fee shall be payable at the time of the issuance of a permit.
- B. Each applicant for each connection from a nonresidential source to the sewer system shall pay the Township a fee as set forth in Chapter 215, Fees, of the Township Code. For purposes of computing the fee, a unit shall be measured to the following schedule:

One Unit for Every 300 Gallons per Day

Type of Establishment	Units	Gallons per Day per Unit
Residential dwellings (including single-family homes, duplex units, townhouses, condominiums, and apartments)		
1 bedroom	Per dwelling	150
2 bedroom	Per dwelling	225
3 bedroom or larger	Per dwelling	300
1 bedroom - age restricted	Per dwelling	110
2 bedroom - age restricted	Per dwelling	170
