ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE *CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY*, PART II, *GENERAL LEGISLATION*, CHAPTER 485, *VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC*, ARTICLE II, *PARKING*, § 485-9, *PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS (Meade Drive)* AND ARTICLE III, *TRAFFIC REGULATIONS*, § 485-24, *ONE-WAY STREETS (Lawton Avenue and Walker Avenue)*

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the *Code of the Township of Hamilton, New Jersey*, Part II, *General Legislation*, Chapter 485, *Vehicles and Traffic*, Article II, *Parking*, § 485-9, *Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets*, and Article III, *Traffic Regulations*, § 485-24, *One-way streets*, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 485

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Article II – Parking

§ 485-9. Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any streets or parts thereof described.
