ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE *CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY*, CHAPTER 485, *VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC*, ARTICLE II, *PARKING*, § 485-17, *RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING*

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the *Code of the Township of Hamilton, New Jersey*, Chapter 485, *Vehicles and Traffic*, Article II, *Parking*, § 485-15, *Parking of trucks, semitrailers, etc., at night*, and Article III, *Traffic Regulations*, § 485-21, *Stop intersections*, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 485

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Article II – Parking

.....

§ 485-17. Residential permit parking.

- A. No person shall park a vehicle on streets or parts of streets as described within the following sections unless an appropriate and current parking permit as issued by the Township is displayed on said vehicle for those streets or parts of streets as described or listed within the following sections:

Name of Street
Adella Avenue
<u>Alexander Avenue (between March 1st and October 31st of each calendar year)</u>
<u>Clearview Avenue (from Fairlawn Avenue to Alexander Avenue, between March 1st and October 31st of each calendar year)</u>
<u>Fairlawn Avenue (between March 1st and October 31st of each calendar year)</u>
<u>Ferndale Avenue (between March 1st and October 31st of each calendar year)</u>
Rosalia Avenue
Victor Avenue

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING, § 485-17, RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING

B. Violations and penalties. Upon conviction of violating this section, the following penalties shall apply: \$100 first offense; \$200 second offense; \$500 each subsequent offense.

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Any Ordinance or Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
