**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING; § 485-19, HANDICAPPED PARKING (Establishing spaces for 452 Lynwood Avenue; 227 Park Lane; 109 Parker Place; 111 Parker Place; 1734 South Broad Street; and 828 South Olden Avenue)**

Whereas the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to establish handicapped parking spaces on streets for private residences;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey, Chapter 485, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II; Parking, § 485-19, Handicapped Parking, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

**Chapter 485**

**VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

**Article II – Parking**

**§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.**

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

<i>Street</i>	<i>Location</i>
<u>452 Lynwood Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08629</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 566 feet north of Elizabeth Avenue and extending to a point 588 feet north of Elizabeth Avenue along the east curb line of Lynwood Avenue.</u>
<u>227 Park Lane</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08609</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 123 feet north of Hollywood Drive and extending to a point 145 feet north of Hollywood Drive along the west curb line of Park Lane.</u>

<u>111 Parker Place</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08609</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 188 feet north of Hollywood Drive extending to a point 210 feet north of Hollywood Drive along the east curb line of Parker Place.</u>
<u>1734 South Broad Street</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 82 feet north of Joseph Street and extending to a point 104 feet north of Joseph Street along the east curb line of South Broad Street.</u>
<u>828 South Olden Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 50 feet north of Partridge Avenue and extending to a point 72 feet north of Partridge Avenue along the east curb line of South Olden Avenue.</u>
