



# Free Naloxone (Narcan)!

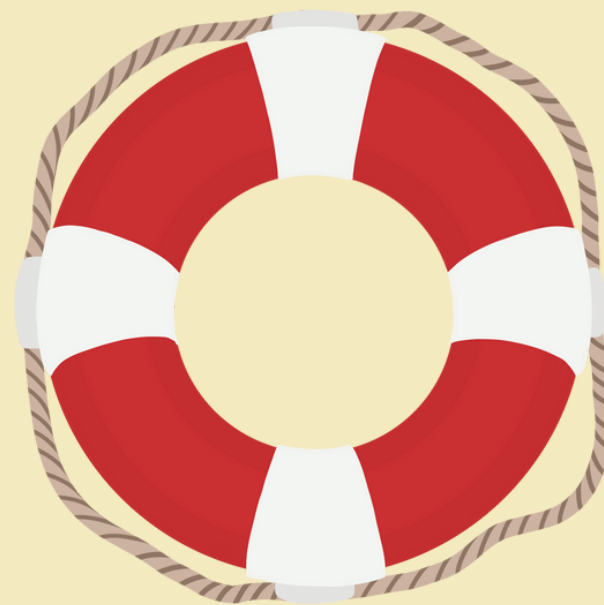
Hamilton Alliance Against Substance Abuse (HAASA) is providing Free Narcan to the public upon request

## What is Naloxone?

Naloxone is a life-saving medication that can reverse an overdose from opioids, including heroin, fentanyl, and prescription opioid medications. Often given as a nasal spray, naloxone is safe and easy to use.

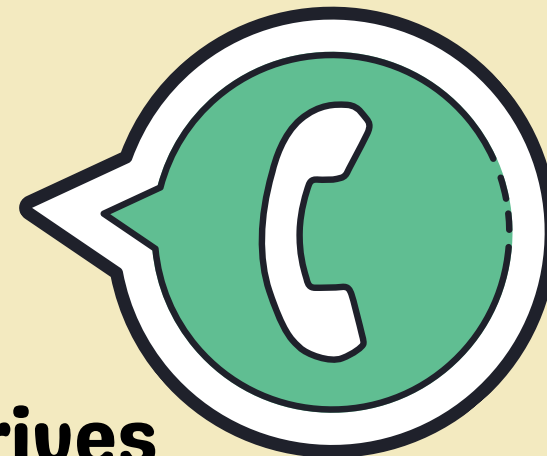


## Why Carry Naloxone?

In nearly 40% of overdose deaths, someone else was present. Having naloxone available allows bystanders to help a fatal overdose and save lives.

## What to Do if You Think Someone is Overdosing

1. Call 911
2. Administer Naloxone, if available
3. Try keeping the person awake and breathing
4. Lay the person on the side to prevent choking
5. Stay with the person until emergency services arrives



★ Most states have laws that may protect a person who is overdosing or the person who called for help from legal trouble. New Jersey is one of them.
