ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING; § 485-19, HANDICAPPED PARKING (Establishing space for 235 Woodlawn Avenue)

Whereas the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to establish handicapped parking spaces on streets for private residences;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey, Chapter 485, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II; Parking, § 485-19, Handicapped Parking, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 485

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Article II – Parking

.....

§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.

.....

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

<i>Street</i>	<i>Location</i>
<u>235 Woodlawn Avenue Hamilton, New Jersey 08609</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 313 feet north of Greenwood Avenue and extending to a point 335 feet north of Greenwood Avenue along the west curb line of Woodlawn Avenue.</u>

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, PART II, GENERAL LEGISLATION, CHAPTER 153, CANNABIS AND MEDICAL CANNABIS, § 153-11, MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PERMITS

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the *Code of the Township of Hamilton, New Jersey, Part II, General Legislation, Chapter 153, Cannabis and Medical Cannabis, § 153-11, Maximum number of permits*, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 153

CANNABIS AND MEDICAL CANNABIS

.....
§ 153-11. Maximum Number of Permits.

- A. The maximum number of permits in the Township for Class 1 Cannabis Cultivators are six, inclusive of microbusinesses and social equity businesses.
- B. The maximum number of permits in the Township for Class 2 cannabis manufacturers are six, inclusive of microbusinesses and social equity businesses.
- C. The maximum number of permits in the Township for Class 3 cannabis wholesalers is one, inclusive of microbusinesses and social equity businesses[;].
- D. The maximum number of permits in the Township for Class 4 cannabis distributors is one, inclusive of microbusinesses and social equity businesses.
- E. The maximum number of permits in the Township for Class 5 cannabis retailers is [one] three, inclusive of a microbusiness and a social equity business.
- F. The maximum number of permits in the Township for a Class 6 cannabis delivery service shall be one, inclusive of microbusinesses and social equity businesses.
- G. The maximum number of permits in the Township for each class of a medical cannabis establishment shall be one.

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Any Ordinance or Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
