ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, HAMILTON TOWNSHIP, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 215, FEES, § 215-1, MUNICIPAL CLERK, AND § 215-8, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the *Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey, Chapter 215, Fees, § 215-1, Municipal Clerk, and § 215-8, Department of Public Safety* as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

**Chapter 215
FEES**

§ 215-1. Municipal Clerk.

- A. Unofficial searches for municipal liens or for municipal improvements authorized but not assessed: \$10 per search. (§ 5-198)
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- Q. Notice of an appeal to the governing body from any final decision of the Board of Adjustment approving an application for a use variance: \$50. (§ 550-197)
- R. Legalized games of chance shall follow the fees as set forth in N.J.A.C. 13:47-4.10 as may be amended.
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§ 215-8. Department of Public Safety.

- A. Division of Police.
 - (1) Permit to purchase pistol or revolver and firearms purchaser identification cards: \$2 each. [(§ 5-198)]
 - (2) Police photography services. [(§ 5-198)]
 - (a) Black and white: \$15 per print.
 - (b) Color: \$20 per print.
 - (3) Background investigations in connection with Township licensing procedures: \$25. [(§ 5-198)]
 - (4) Employment of off-duty police officers. [(§ 5-66)]
 - (a) Rates of compensation; administrative fees; payment for services. Rates of compensation for contracting the services of off-duty Township police officers shall be as follows:

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, HAMILTON TOWNSHIP, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 215, FEES, § 215-1, MUNICIPAL CLERK, AND § 215-8, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

1. For all [traffic] security and nontraffic assignments, the rate shall be \$60 per hour, plus a \$10 per hour administrative fee to the Township, and any administrative fees assessed by third parties.
 2. For all construction project traffic assignments, the rate shall be \$90 per hour, plus a \$10 per hour administrative fee to the Township, and any administrative fees assessed by third parties.
 3. Cancellation with less than 24 hours' notice will result in a payment of two hours at the appropriate rate.
 4. Cancellation or early completion on the day scheduled for a construction project traffic assignment shall result in payment for the full time scheduled, except for cancellation after the start as a result of inclement weather, machinery and/or manpower issues, or improper construction plans, which will then result in a payment of four hours at the appropriate rate.
 5. Payment for all assignments shall be in accordance with the requirements set forth in [§ 5-66] §5-59.6.
- (b) Use of marked police vehicles. In the event that a party or employer employs any off-duty Township police officer pursuant to this section, in addition to any compensation to be paid to the Township pursuant to the requirements herein, there shall also be a fee of \$12 per hour per vehicle for the use of marked police vehicles.

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Any Ordinance or Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
