ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE *CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY*, CHAPTER 485, *VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC*, ARTICLE II, *PARKING*; § 485-19, *HANDICAPPED PARKING (Establishing spaces for 18 Bismark Avenue; 179 Main Street; and 1126 William Street)*

Whereas the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to establish handicapped parking spaces on streets for private residences;

Now, Therefore, *Be It Ordained* by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the *Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey*, Chapter 485, *Vehicles and Traffic*, Article II; *Parking*, § 485-19, *Handicapped Parking*, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 485

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Article II – Parking

§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

<i>Street</i>	<i>Location</i>
<u>18 Bismark Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 164 feet east of Dewey Avenue and extending to a point 186 feet east of Dewey Avenue, along the north side curb line of Bismark Avenue, in front of the residence.</u>
<u>179 Main Street</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08620</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 360 feet west of Church Street and extending to a point 382 feet west of Church Street, along the north side curb line of Main Street, across the street from the residence.</u>
