**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING, § 485-19, HANDICAPPED PARKING (Repealing spaces established at 430 Tindall Avenue by Ordinance No. 07-030 and 342 Schiller Avenue by Ordinance 14-080)**

*Whereas* the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to repeal certain handicapped parking spaces that were established on streets for private residences;

*Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained* by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the *Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey, Chapter 485, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II, Parking, § 485-19, Handicapped Parking*, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

**Chapter 485**

**VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

**Article II – Parking**

**§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.**

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

[342 Schiller Avenue Hamilton, New Jersey 08610]	[Beginning at a point 137 feet west of the curb line of Sewell Avenue and extending to a point 159 feet west of the curb line of Sewell Avenue on the north curb of Schiller Avenue]
