**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE *CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY*, CHAPTER 485, *VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC*, ARTICLE II, *PARKING*; § 485-19, *HANDICAPPED PARKING (Establishing spaces for 36 Annabelle Avenue; 19 Fitzrandolph Avenue; 105 Francis Avenue; 70 Reed Avenue; 339 Schiller Avenue; and 1854 South Broad Street)***

Whereas the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to establish handicapped parking spaces on streets for private residences;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the *Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey*, Chapter 485, *Vehicles and Traffic*, Article II; *Parking*, § 485-19, *Handicapped Parking*, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

**Chapter 485**

**VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

**Article II – Parking**

**§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.**

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

<i>Street</i>	<i>Location</i>
<u>36 Annabelle Avenue Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 347 feet north of Bow Hill Avenue and extending to a point 366 feet north of Bow Hill Avenue along the east side curb line of Annabelle Avenue, in front of the residence.</u>

<u>19 Fitzrandolph Avenue Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 125 feet south of Lalor Street and extending to a point 145 feet south of Lalor Street along the west side curb line of Fitzrandolph Avenue, in front of the residence.</u>
<u>105 Francis Avenue Hamilton, New Jersey 08629</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 30 feet south of Tuttle Avenue and extending to a point 50 feet south of Tuttle Avenue along the west side curb line of Francis Avenue, in front of the residence.</u>
<u>70 Reed Avenue Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 200 feet north of Bow Hill Avenue and extending to a point 222 feet north of Bow Hill Avenue along the east side curb line of Reed Avenue, in front of the residence.</u>
<u>339 Schiller Avenue Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 108 feet west of Sewell Avenue and extending to a point 128 feet west of Sewell Avenue along the south side curb line of Schiller Avenue, in front of the residence.</u>
<u>1854 South Broad Street Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 99 feet south of Lily Street and extending to a point 109 feet south of Lily Street along the east side curb line of South Broad Street, in front of the residence.</u>
