

**NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT**  
**TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON**  
**FY 2022 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The purpose of this notice is to present a substantial amendment to the Township of Hamilton’s FY 2022 Annual Action Plan for the use of Community Development Block Grant funds.

In accordance with CDBG program regulations, the Township is allowed to make substantial amendments to its Annual Action Plan and Budget in accordance with the Township’s Citizen Participation Plan.

Hamilton has determined that it is necessary to amend the approved CDBG program for the previously approved program year FY 2022. This is considered a substantial amendment in accordance with Hamilton’s Citizen Participation Plan as the following applies: Changes in the use of CDBG funds from one eligible activity to another.

The amendment proposed is as follows:

This document will be available to the public for a period of thirty (30) days until January 30, 2025, after which time the Substantial Amendment will be considered by the Township Council for submittal to HUD for approval.

A Public Hearing on the Substantial Amendment Plan will be held on January 14, 2025, at 2:00 P.M at the Hamilton Township Council Chamber Room located at 2090 Greenwood Ave. Hamilton, NJ 08609.
