- Pay via ACH Checking Account Debit (NO charge as of printing of calendar)
- Pay via Credit Card/Debit Card or E-Check (convenience fees paid to third-party provider for transactions; NOT paid to Township)
- Make future Automatic Withdrawal Payments (Can Sign Up To Pay Future Tax Bills, Sewer Bills or Both)

### REMINDER FOR RESIDENTS WHO ALREADY HAVE AUTOMATIC WITHDRAWALS FOR PROPERTY TAX & SEWER PAYMENTS

If you have previously signed up for Automatic Tax and/or Sewer Payments, the Automatic Payments WILL CONTINUE to be taken unless you "opt-out" by contacting Hamilton's Tax Collection Office in writing. Normally, the Automatic Withdrawal will be taken After the 1st of the Month, but Before the Late Fee Date.

### **HAMILTON'S STORMWATER MANAGEMENT EFFORTS**

Hamilton performs a great deal of work when it comes to stormwater management. In 2011, Hamilton partnered with the Rutgers Cooperative Extension (RCE) Water Resources Program to evaluate watershed & stormwater management issues & develop recommendations for improving & protecting community water resources. Goals include: Engaging the community in water resource protection, Managing water quality, Minimizing localized flooding, Implementing Phase II stormwater controls & Improving stormwater facility maintenance. **Do NOT Flush These Items Down the Drain:** Disposable Wipes or Baby Wipes \* Disposable Gloves \* Diapers \* Paper Towels \* Grease/Oil \* Feminine Hygiene Products \* Any Medication

**Help Keep Our Water Clean:** Limit use of fertilizers & pesticides \* Properly use & dispose of hazardous products \* Do NOT pour hazardous products down storm drains (they are usually connected to local waterbodies & this water is NOT treated) \* Do NOT push trash in storm drains \* Dispose of yard waste properly \* Leaves & grass should NOT be put down or near storm drains

# ABOUT THE TOWNSHIP SEAL

The Township Seal was adopted March 2, 1976. It was designed by Miss Lynda Bruschini, at that time a ninth-grade student at Reynolds Junior High School. The Seal incorporates significant dates and symbols of 'Hamilton Township history.

The circular Seal includes an inner circle divided into three parts, each including a date and a symbol.

The earliest date is 1678, the year that the ship, the "Shield," arrived at the present location of Burlington City on December 10, 1678. The Shield's English passengers became the first European settlers of what was to become Hamilton Township. The Indian pictured in this section represents the Leni-Lenape Indian tribe, the first inhabitants of this area.

In the second section, the date 1686 was the year of founding of the Township of Nottingham, which included all of the present Township of Hamilton and part of Trenton. Nottingham was formed from part of the Yorkshire Tenth, the original geographic area that included Hamilton and surrounding areas of present Mercer and Burlington counties. The Township was named for the Nottingham in England. The tree and monument which are pictured in this part of the Seal are located on Quakerbridge Road. The monument commemorates George Washington's march along this road from Trenton to Princeton.

The date in the third section of the Seal, 1842, was the year of incorporation of the Township of Hamilton from a part of the Township of Nottingham located in Mercer County. The final boundaries of Hamilton Township were established in 1851, when remaining parts of Nottingham were divided between Hamilton Township and the city of Trenton. The reason for the choice of name is not documented, although some suggest it was to honor Alexander Hamilton. The steeple and clock of the present Municipal Building are pictured in this section of the Seal.

This inner circle has a border identifying Yorkshire Tenth and Nottingham, the two earlier geographic names for Hamilton. An outside border contains the name of Township of Hamilton, and repeats the incorporation date, 1842. The banner identifies Hamilton's home county, Mercer. The eagle and shield signify the Great Seal of the United States.
