RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, COUNTY OF MERCER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ESTABLISHING CASH-PAYMENT PROCEDURES FOR TAX COLLECTIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION OF OVERAGES TO FUTURE BALANCES


WHEREAS, the Township of Hamilton accepts property-tax and municipal-charge payments through the Office of the Tax Collector; and

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to establish consistent procedures for handling cash payments, improve efficiency, safeguard municipal funds, and eliminate the administrative difficulties associated with providing change; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Hamilton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Tax Collector shall continue to accept cash as a valid form of payment for property taxes and municipal charges.
2. No cash change shall be returned for payments exceeding the amount due.
3. Any overpayment shall be credited to the taxpayer's account and applied to future taxes or municipal charges. No refunds shall be issued for cash overpayments.
4. The Tax Collector shall post notice of this policy in the tax office and on the Township website.
5. The Tax Collector and Chief Financial Officer are authorized to take all necessary steps to implement this policy and ensure proper accounting of overages.
